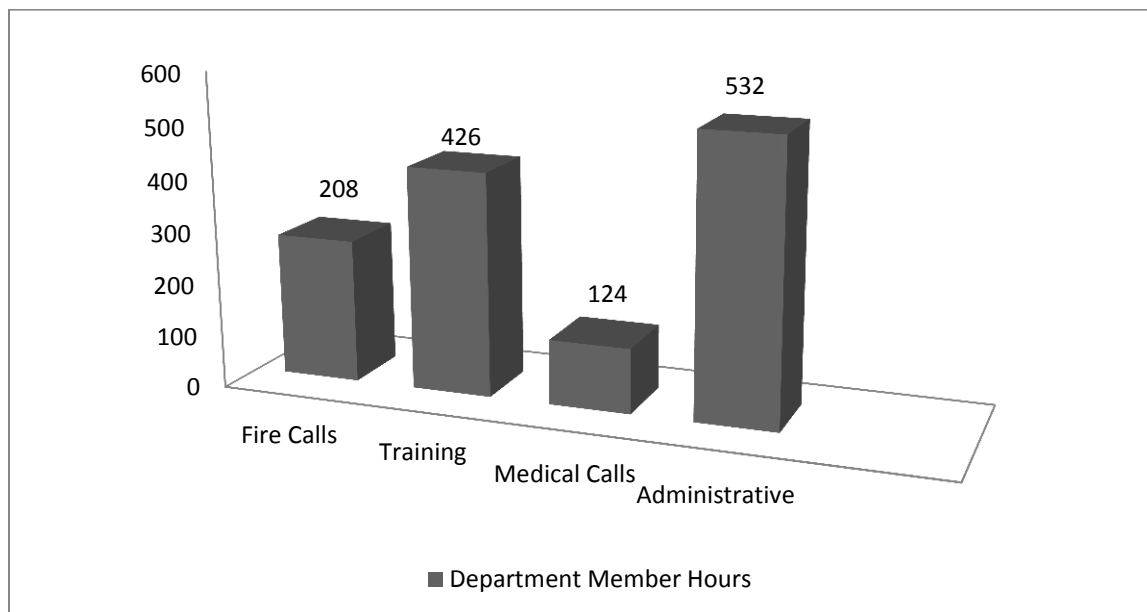

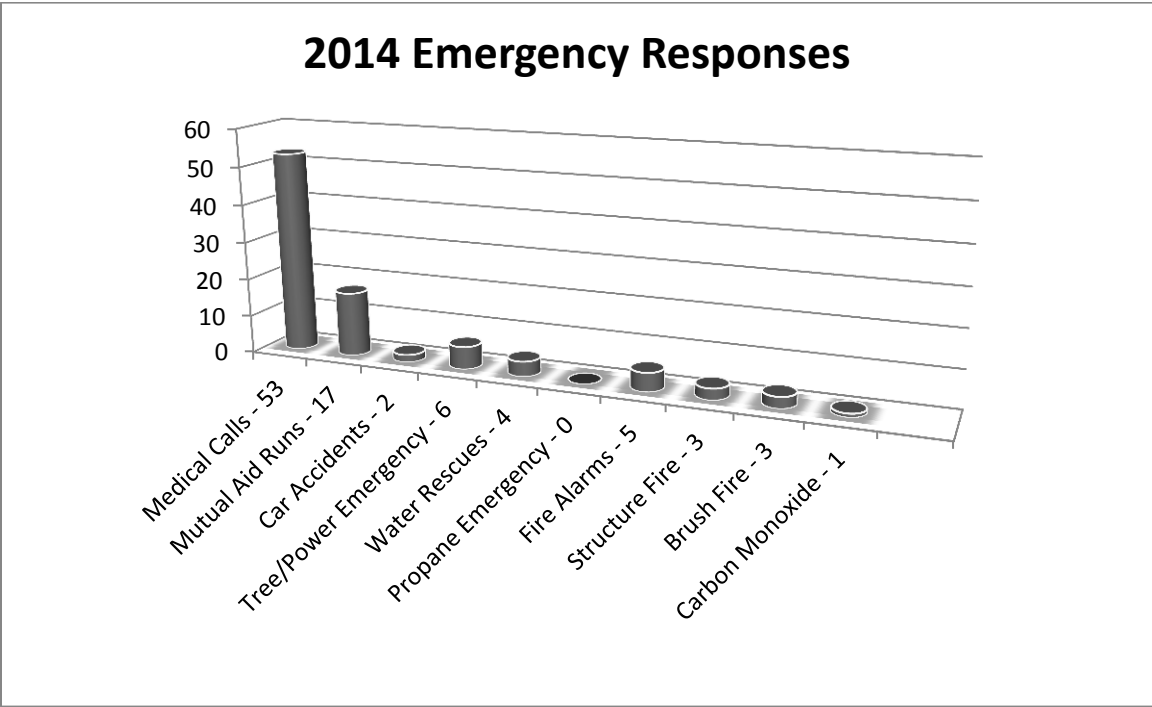
## *2015 ANNUAL REPORT*

Answering emergency calls, performing fire prevention programs and participating in training events led to department members logging a total of 1,290 working hours for 2015.

The department takes great pride in the dedication our members show in their willingness to train. Department members spent 426 hours training in 2015. Training areas of focus were in the areas of pump operations, fire attack, self-preservation, victim search and removal, driver training and boat operations.



The department is constantly working to maintain our staffing levels which can be a challenge in small communities. While the department has consistently had a full roster we find we are very thin with day time coverage. We are continuing our efforts at recruiting personnel that can help with day time response.



In 2015 the department contracted for fire inspection service for our towns businesses. This was done to give our residents the best possible service. That amount of rules and regulations that are required to be known, inspected and enforced is constantly increasing. While the company we used did complete this task, moving forward in 2016 we have contracted with the Sturgeon Bay Fire Department. We feel they will provide a more professional service that our residents and business owners have come to expect.

The fire department would like to extend our deepest appreciation to the support that our taxpayers give us year after year. In 2016 we will continue to work to improve the services we provide to the town.
